JOB DESCRIPTION

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Provide piano accompaniment during Choir class, two days a week
- Provide piano accompaniment during Choir concerts and performances (2 Concerts on Wednesday December 11th, 2019 and two Concerts on Thursday, May 21st 2020)
- Meet with the Music teacher or take time to prepare for the 15 minutes prior to each class.

- Ability to sight read as well as perform prepared repertoire provided by choir director
- The capacity to work effectively with diverse populations
- A comfort with, and an ability to accompany choirs
